### Important notes for your airfare and hotel consideration:

If you plan to attend a Clinic (additional fee) or Pre-Conference Networking, it's recommended you arrive Sunday, September 30<sup>th</sup> at your leisure.

The conference will end around 2pm on Wednesday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>, so you can either leave that evening or on Thursday, October 4<sup>th</sup> if you do not have plans to extend your stay.

## Expense Checklist

### Registration Fees

#### > Full Conference Registration:

- Early Bird: \$995 (offered through May 31, 2018)
- Summer Rate: \$1145 (offered June 1st, 2018 - August 31st, 2018)
- Standard: \$1295 (September 1st, 2018 - September 30th, 2018)

> Beginner and Advanced Clinics: \$595

> Attendee Appreciation Event Guest Pass: \$125

## Airfare

Calculate your airfare based on your departure city to/from **Denver**.

We recommend flying into **Denver International Airport (DIA)**.

## Ground Transportation

There are several options for ground transportation from DIA.

**Uber, Lyft, Taxis:** These range in prices of \$30-\$100 from DIA to the Hyatt Regency Denver depending on the date and time range; all ride services are readily available at DIA.

**A Line Commuter Train:** The light rail travel option is the most economic, with a one-way pass costing \$9 per day. The travel time is approximately 37 minutes from the DEN (DIA stop) to the Union Station stop downtown.

**Please Note:** These travel options are only suggestions, please book your travel to best fit your schedule and budget. As a reminder, hotel, airfare, and ground transportation costs are **not** included in your Conference Registration Fee.

## Additional Costs

**Hotel** - \$259/night (single- and double-occupancy) + 14.75% tax = \$297.20/night (multiplied by number of nights needed)

**Meals** - See below for details on meals included with certain registration fees. All other meals are at the attendee's expense.

- **Monday:** Breakfast and lunch is included with Clinic pass only.
- **Tuesday:** Breakfast and lunch are both included with the Full Conference pass. The Attendee Appreciation Event in the evening typically serves as dinner for most conference attendees.
- **Wednesday:** Breakfast and lunch are both included with the Full Conference pass.
